**System hardware and infrastructure:** Lagging infrastructure that results in non-optimised systems can drive users to work manually to ease their frustrations. Be sure to consult your system provider on the hardware and security requirements that lead to optimised system performance.

Keep users informed of system releases: Make sure regular system users receive and review the Prophet monthly release communications and encourage them to apply their minds regarding possible upgrades that could enhance their day-to-day system usage.
